

60-MILES RADIUS AROUND LA GRANGE

- **GFCF Technical Education Scholarship (ONLINE ONLY)**

This is a minimum \$1,000 scholarship offering financial assistance to a high school graduating senior who intends to further their education and training beyond their high school degree at an accredited trade school or program. Factors to be considered include community service and volunteer activities, financial need, a sound academic record and the character of the applicant. Priority will be given to students not in the top ten percent of their class but excludes no applicant.

ONLY FAYETTE & LAVACA COUNTY SCHOOLS

- **Professions of the Healing Arts Scholarship (ONLINE ONLY)**

This is a minimum \$1,500 scholarship offering financial assistance to high school graduating senior from Lavaca and Fayette County who intends to pursue a career in audiology, speech-language pathology, physical therapy, occupational therapy, or mental/behavioral health.

ONLY FAYETTE, COLORADO & LAVACA COUNTY SCHOOLS

- **Grow Wings Scholarship (Turtle Wing Foundation) (ONLINE ONLY)**

Grow Wings Scholarship – this applicant must be actively participating in Special Education or following a 504 Plan. The committee may award up to three scholarships per year for a period of two consecutive years, at \$1,000 per year. The total scholarship amount per recipient may not exceed \$2,000. Year 2 funds will require follow-up with the Scholarship Committee and verification of continued eligibility.

- **Give Wings Scholarship (Turtle Wing Foundation) (ONLINE ONLY)**

Give Wings Scholarship – this applicant must be pursuing an education that will lead them to working with children with learning challenges in some way. The committee may award one scholarship per year for a period of two consecutive years, at \$1,000 per year. The total scholarship amount per recipient may not exceed \$2,000. Year 2 funds will require follow-up with the Scholarship Committee and verification of continued eligibility.

- Jack Hooper Scholarship (Turtle Wing Foundation) (ONLINE ONLY)

Jack Hooper Memorial Scholarship – this will be awarded to a student who has exhibited the qualities of acceptance, kindness, inclusion, and service. This might be through volunteerism, work, or life experiences. The committee may award up to two scholarships per year, each valued between \$500 and \$1,000. The total scholarship amount per recipient shall not exceed \$1,000.

ONLY FAYETTE COUNTY HIGH SCHOOLS

- Building Brighter Futures Scholarship (ONLINE ONLY)

This is a minimum \$750 scholarship offering financial assistance to a high school graduating senior or currently enrolled college student who intends to further their education at an accredited university, college, or trade school. Scholarship applicants and recipients are able to reapply during the following semesters.

ONLY AT FLATONIA HIGH SCHOOL

- Joe & Carolyn Bailey Scholarship (ONLINE ONLY)

This is a \$2,500 scholarship, awarded annually for all four years of undergraduate study, offering financial assistance to first-generation students graduating from Flatonia High School who intend to further their education and training beyond their high school degree at an accredited university, college, or trade school. Factors considered include community service and volunteer activities, financial need, a sound academic record, and the character of the applicant. While priority is given to students outside the top ten percent of their class, all applicants are encouraged to apply.

- Suzy Romberg Scholarship (ONLINE ONLY)

This is a minimum \$2,500 scholarship offering financial assistance to first-generation students graduating from Flatonia High School who intend to further their education and training beyond their high school degree at an accredited university, college, or trade school. Factors to be considered include community service and volunteer activities, financial need, a sound academic record, and the character of the applicant. Priority will be given to students not in the top ten percent of their class but excludes no applicant.



Scholarship Opportunities

ONLY AT LA GRANGE HIGH SCHOOL

- **GFCF ML Scholarship (ONLINE ONLY)**

The FCF ML Scholarship provides financial assistance to graduating La Grange High School students pursuing education and training beyond high school at an accredited university or college, with priority given to students pursuing STEM degrees or attending The University of Texas at Austin, Rice, Harvard, Yale, Princeton, MIT, or Stanford (if they demonstrate financial ability to attend for four years). This 2025 scholarship offers up to \$20,000 in funding, supporting students through completion of their undergraduate degree or up to five years, with funds disbursed in equal amounts at the start of fall and spring semesters. Summer funding is generally not provided, though a one-semester break may be allowed for extenuating circumstances.

- **Cesar Villasana Memorial Scholarship (PAPER ONLY)**

The Cesar Villasana Memorial Scholarship is presented in memory of Cesar Villasana who passed away from leukemia in 2022 at the age of 15 while he was a sophomore at La Grange High School. He was a kind, funny, positive person who loved and accepted everyone.

Applicants should be a graduating senior from La Grange High School who intends to further his/her education at an accredited trade school, college, or university. Factors to be considered include the character and financial need of the applicant.

- **Sampuesana 7 Scholarship (PAPER ONLY)**

This is a minimum of \$500 scholarship offering financial assistance to a La Grange High School graduating senior who intends to further their education and training beyond their high school degree at an accredited university, college, or trade school. Factors to be considered include scholastic achievement, community service and volunteer activities, extracurricular activities and work experience.

ONLY FOR CURRENT POST -SECONDARY

- **Building Brighter Futures Scholarship (ONLINE ONLY)**

This is a minimum \$750 scholarship offering financial assistance to a high school graduating senior or currently enrolled college student who intends to further their
